Appointment of New Town Attorney

Mayor Wright told the board he had a discussion with Attorney Bartholomew and about representing the Town. He stated Attorney Bartholomew would be glad to. His rate is \$250 for meeting night. If it goes over 3 hours it is then \$125 an hour.

Commissioner Meador made the motion to appoint Attorney Bartholomew as town attorney. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kearney and accepted unanimously.

Declaring a Town State of Emergency


Mayor Wright told the board this will the Town to set some boundaries such as a stronger curfew if need than set by State or County.


ADJOURNMENT
