



**THE TOWN OF FRANKLINTON  
ADOPT-A-STREET PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

**The Town of Franklinton  
and**

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(Name of business, organization or individual, hereinafter the “Entity”) recognize the need and the desirability of litter-free and visually-improved streets.

The Adopt-A-Street program has been established for community and civic organizations as well as private businesses and industry to contribute toward the effort of maintaining cleaner and beautiful streets in the Town of Franklinton. The purpose of the Adopt-A-Street program is to encourage community residents and organizations to adopt residential blocks of streets and keep them litter-free. The adopted areas are to be cleaned every 2 months in an effort to maintain a healthy environment and to produce feelings of pride in our beautiful Town.

The Entity understands that the work to be performed can result in physical injury or damage to property and agrees to assume the risk. The Entity hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the Town of Franklinton and any neighborhood committee, their officers, employees and agents respectively from liability for any and all claims, damages or injuries of any kind or nature which the Entity, its employees, members or agents may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program. **The Entity agrees that signs bearing the group’s name will be installed solely at the discretion of The Town of Franklinton, and such cost will be absorbed by the Town of Franklinton.**

The text to be placed on the sign is:

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The Town of Franklinton recognizes the Entity as the adopting organization for:

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Street Name and Description (from what point to what point)

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The Entity understands that at least 1000 linear feet of Town maintained streets must be included, and agrees to select from the provided list of available streets for the program. The Entity volunteers are to pick up litter **at least every 2 months** (or more if necessary) along its section of street for a period beginning \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, and ending \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_. This agreement will automatically renew annually once the ending period is reached.

Items provided for cleanup by the Town of Franklinton are **gloves, trash bags and safety vests.**

**If safety vests are misplaced, the entity will be responsible for their replacement.**

**The following must be adhered to in the cleanup and reporting processes:**

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- Items collected by Adopt-A-Street participants should be litter and debris that can fit into trash bags provided.
  - In the report of pickup, the Town of Franklinton shall be notified of large items, tires, appliances, or other bulky items on streets.
  - Bags of collected trash should not exceed 20-25 pounds.
  - Bags must be placed in clusters near an intersection or along the street.
  - Bags should not be placed in the road or on a sidewalk.
  - Bulky items should be in a separate pile, NOT on top of or under the trash bags.
  - Bags of recycling should also be in separate piles.
  - Items that may be recycled are glass, plastic, and aluminum cans.
  - The Adopt-A-Street contact person should call, fax or e-mail Town Hall the next business day to report where the bags have been left so that the Town staff may ensure pick up and accurate recordkeeping.
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
