

Franklinton Board of Commissioners  
Budget Workshop  
February 4, 2009

The Franklinton Board of Commissioners budget workshop was called to order by Mayor Elic Senter at 7:00 p.m.

Board members present were Mayor Elic A. Senter, Commissioners Joe Cutchins Jr., Anita Fuller, James Worley and Art Wright. Others present were Town Manager Larry Carver, Town Clerk Kim Worley, Planning & Zoning Administrator Tammy Ray, Public Works Director Raymond Bragg, and Water Plant Superintendent Richard Hinkle. Commissioner Anita Fuller and Chief Ray Gilliam were absent.

Town Manager Larry Carver presented the Board preliminary budget suggestions in an attempt to answer some of the more significant issues that the Board must address in the upcoming budgeting process. These issues included:


- Employee health care
- Employee retirement benefits
- Commissioner's benefits
- Uniforms
- Capacity & debt service fees
- Powell bill expenditures
- Cemetery fees
- Liability insurance
- Water plant issues
- Employee salary issues
- Other contingencies

The Board discussed the budget material presented to them. Much discussion was raised around Commissioners benefits, salary increases, uniforms and employee health care. Each Board member shared their thoughts to provide Mr. Carver some direction.

There being no other business the workshop was adjourned.
