

Franklinton Board of Commissioners
Workshop

Mayor Pro Tempore Anita Fuller called the Franklinton Board of Commissioners Workshop to order at 7:00 p.m.

Those present were; Mayor Pro Tempore Anita Fuller; Commissioners John Allers, Alvin Holden, Brad Kearney and Phil Meador; Town Manager Tammy and Town Clerk Kim Worley.

Mayor Wright was absent.

Others present were Police Chief John Green and Street Supervisor Tim Jacobs.

Mayor Pro Tempore Anita Fuller stated the Board has issues that she feels needs to be discussed and start working toward a solution. She stated that everyone is very over worked and needs help.

She stated the Town needs to look at hiring another Town Clerk to take Town Clerk Kim Worley place. Commissioner Meador's stated that hopefully Kim Worley will consider coming to work part time.

Mayor Pro Tempore Fuller said that the Police Department is understaffed and with the growth coming to Franklinton we need to go ahead and add to the department.

She stated that currently Chief Green is handling the Parks and Recreation Program and we need to hire someone part time to handle Parks and Recreations. The program has grown beyond our expectations and we need someone to help with this program.

Mayor Pro Tempore Anita Fuller stated Town Manager Tammy Ray is way overworked and she needs help. She is handling everything for her job, along with Planning and Zoning and Code Enforcement. She stated we need a Code Enforcement person full time to handle that and to help with the Planning and Zoning.

Mayor Pro Tempore Anita Fuller stated that things are starting to move fast and we are starting to grow and the Board needs to stay on top of the growth.

Mr. Bruce Naegelen from NC Department of Commerce, the Rural Economic Development Division presented the Board with an Economic Development Strategic Plan. He stated the Town's plan should have a five year time horizon and will provide framework for improved

economic prosperity opportunities. He stated the Rural Planning Center will work with the Town and he went over how the Town should start the process.

He also presented to the Board a proposal for Downtown Development Assessment.


Town Manager Tammy Ray thanked Mr. Mark Lemmon for getting in touch with the NC Department of Commerce and having them contact us.
